COLD AND FLU SEASON – THE FLU IS OFTEN CONFUSED WITH THE COMMON COLD, BUT FLU SYMPTOMS TEND TO DEVELOP QUICKLY (USUALLY 1 TO 4 DAYS AFTER A PERSON IS EXPOSED TO THE FLU VIRUS) AND ARE USUALLY MORE SEVERE THAN THE TYPICAL SNEEZING AND STUFFINESS OF A COLD.

#### SYMPTOMS OF THE FLU MAY INCLUDE:



FEVER CHILLS HEAD MUSCLE ACHES DIZZINESS TIREDNESS NAUSEA OR VOMITING DIARRHEA COUGH SORE THROAT RUNNY NOSE WEAKNESS


#### **WAYS TO PREVENT THE FLU:**

- WASH YOUR HANDS KEEP FINGERS AND HANDS AWAY FROM NOSE AND MOUTH.
- NEVER PICK UP USED TISSUES

- COVER YOUR MOUTH AND NOSE WITH YOUR ELBOW OR A TISSUE WHEN YOU
  COUGH OR SNEEZE.

# SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING DAYS

DEAR PARENTS/GUARDIANS,

THE PURPOSE OF THIS EMAIL IS TO COMMUNICATE A CHANGE TO OUR PROCEDURES AND SCHEDULES FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR SHOULD WE HAVE TO CANCEL A DAY OF ONSITE LEARNING DUE TO A WEATHER EVENT OR OTHER UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES THAT PREVENTS US FROM FOLLOWING OUR NORMAL DAILY ROUTINES.

IN THE EVENT THAT WE NEED TO CANCEL OUR REGULAR SCHOOL DAY, WE WILL BE IMPLEMENTING SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING. THIS MEANS THAT WE WILL BE PROVIDING LIVE INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS ON DAYS WHEN WE ARE UNABLE TO ATTEND ONSITE. OUR HOPE IS THAT THIS CHANGE IN OUR DELIVERY OF INSTRUCTION WILL BETTER SERVE STUDENTS AND KEEP LEARNING MOVING FORWARD IN A MORE PRODUCTIVE AND ENGAGING FORMAT. THIS CHANGE ALSO ALLOWS FAMILIES AND TEACHERS THE ABILITY TO MORE ACCURATELY PLAN AHEAD FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR AS WE WILL NOT BE LIMITED TO THREE WEATHER CANCELLATION DAYS WITH THIS FORMAT SHOULD WE HAVE AN ESPECIALLY CHALLENGING WINTER. (PLEASE NOTE: SHOULD WE HAVE A WEATHER CANCELLATION DURING DECEMBER 18TH-21ST, THEN WE WILL UTILIZE THE DECEMBER 22ND MAKE-UP DATE.)

THE DAILY SCHEDULES FOR LIVE INSTRUCTION AT EACH LEVEL OF LEARNING ARE PROVIDED BELOW:

ELEMENTARY: 9:30AM-NOON

MIDDLE SCHOOL: 9:00AM-12:55PM

· HIGH SCHOOL: 9:00AM-12:25PM

THE EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS WILL BE THAT THEY ARE ACTIVELY ATTENDING LIVE SESSIONS ON SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING DAYS. HAVING STATED THIS, WE DO UNDERSTAND THAT SITUATIONS ARISE THAT DO NOT MAKE THIS POSSIBLE, AND FLEXIBILITY AND ALTERNATIVES WILL BE PROVIDED TO STUDENTS WHEN NECESSARY.

WE WANTED TO MAKE YOU AWARE OF THIS CHANGE IN OUR PROCEDURES EARLY IN THE SCHOOL YEAR, AND INFORMATION SPECIFIC TO YOUR CHILD'S CLASS(ES) AND BUILDING WILL BE PROVIDED BY YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER/PRINCIPAL.
WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO SEEING STUDENTS BACK IN OUR BUILDINGS TOMORROW, AND I HOPE THAT EVERYONE HAS A GREAT START TO THE SCHOOL YEAR!
